

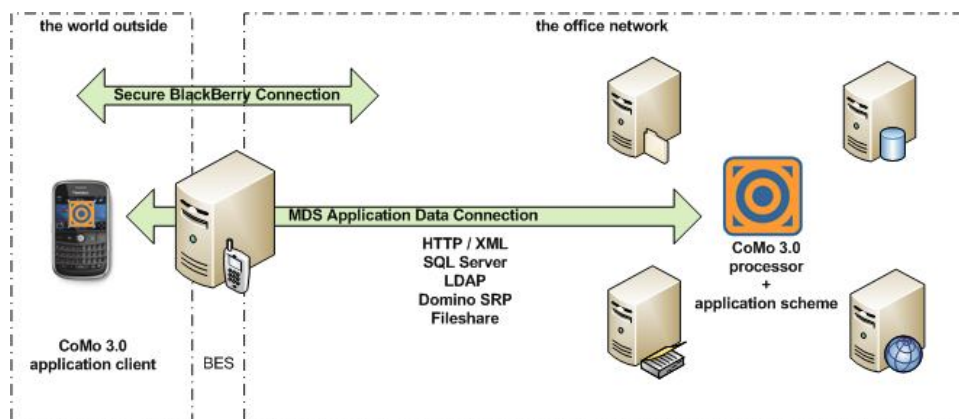
e-office Content Mobilizer 3.0 for BlackBerry

Do you recognize one or more of the following scenarios?

- You want to run more applications on your BlackBerry than just push mail en calendar
- Your sales force need direct access to their contact details and visit reports at all times
- The management want real time access to the companies KPI's any time, any place
- Your want to access your company's product catalog without starting a laptop or PC
- Your field service organization needs real-time access to their 'trouble ticket' system
- The intranet is not optimized to work well on your BlackBerry handheld
- Your customers want to access your extranet or website from their BlackBerry
- You run SAP, Peoplesoft, Microsoft CRM or other ERP systems and need that data on your BlackBerry

You think it's expensive or difficult to solve these scenarios? The answer is NO!

e-office mobile created a perfect solution called **Content Mobilizer for BlackBerry 3.0**, in short **CoMo 3.0**. With CoMo 3.0 we bring your back office applications to your BlackBerry. It's secure, it's manageable, it's extremely fast and best of all it's cost efficient.



- ✓ The end-user gets a new icon on the BlackBerry Smartphone, the CoMo 3.0 application client, that enables them to search through their content sources any place any time. All searches initiated by the end-user make use of BlackBerry's always on and secure network connection with your office.
- ✓ On a computer within your office network (most of the times the BlackBerry Enterprise Server) the CoMo 3.0 processor application is installed. The CoMo 3.0 processor collects the content, on end-user request, from one or more content sources located in your office network. The real-time collected content is then optimized and pushed back to the BlackBerry. The handheld then presents the content in an intuitive user interface. A hosted solution is available as well.
- ✓ The CoMo 3.0 client can interact with various BlackBerry applications like mail, phone, address book, BlackBerry Maps and the BlackBerry browser.
- ✓ Implementing Content Mobilizer for BlackBerry is pretty simple. Together with a consultant you define the mapping to the content sources and the look & feel of the application on the BlackBerry. It's then all saved in an 'application scheme', which is an XML scheme.
- ✓ You want to change the representation of the content on the BlackBerry or maybe your content sources have changed? By updating the 'application scheme' for the CoMo 3.0 processor all CoMo 3.0 application clients will be updated automatically. CoMo application distribution is built in and so no end-user interaction is needed to send out these updates.

Technical requirements CoMo 3.0 processor:

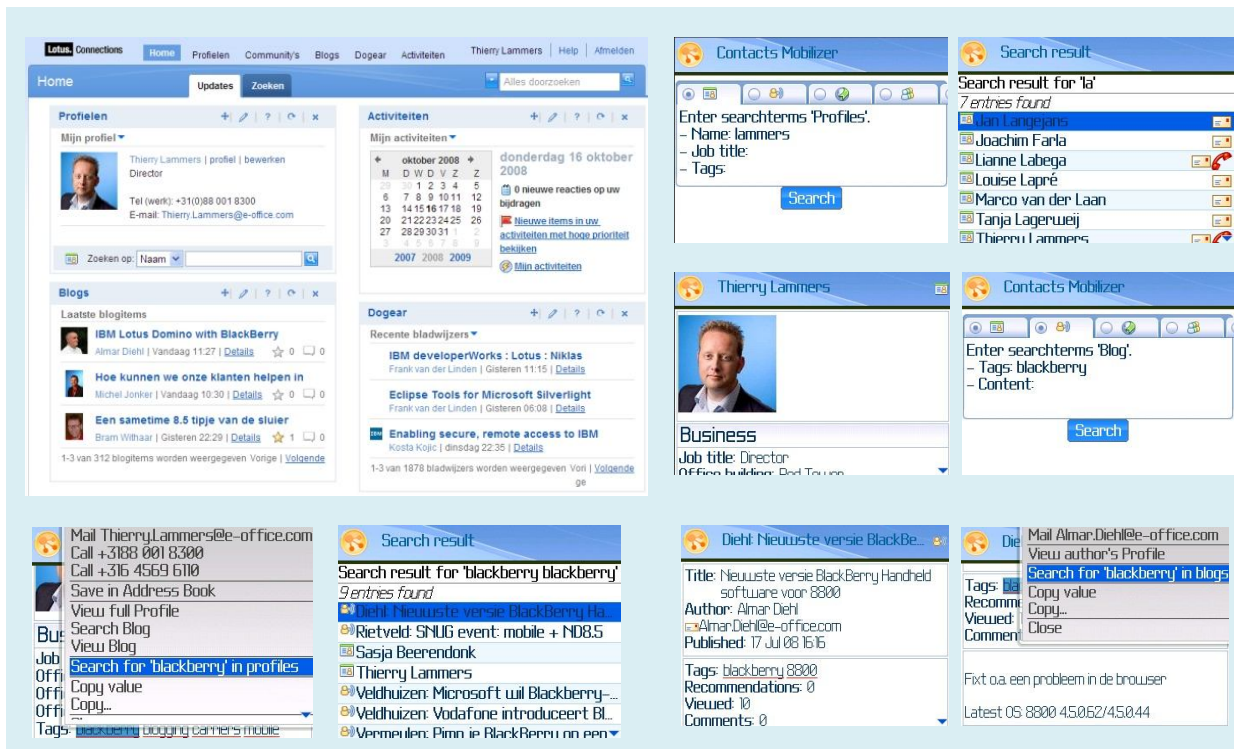
- runs as a Java stand-alone application on a JRE 1.5 or newer Java runtime
- installs and runs without problems on your BlackBerry Enterprise Server
- BlackBerry Mobile Data System (MDS) must be activated for CoMo 3.0 users

Technical requirements CoMo 3.0 client:

- BlackBerry handheld software v4.2 or newer
- Tested on BlackBerry types: 81x0 (Pearl), 8220 (Kickstart), 83x0 (Curve), 870x, 88x0, 8900 (Curve), 9000 (Bold), 9500 (Storm)

Available connectors:

- comma separated ASCII files hosted on a web server or fileserver
- Microsoft SQL Server 2000, 2003, 2008
- Microsoft Exchange 2003 public folders
- Microsoft Sharepoint 2003 en 2007
- Lotus Domino 5.5 or newer through RPC and web access (basic authentication en LTPA)
- webservices (XML)
- Lotus Connections 2.0
- LDAP directories
- Image files (GIF en JPG)
